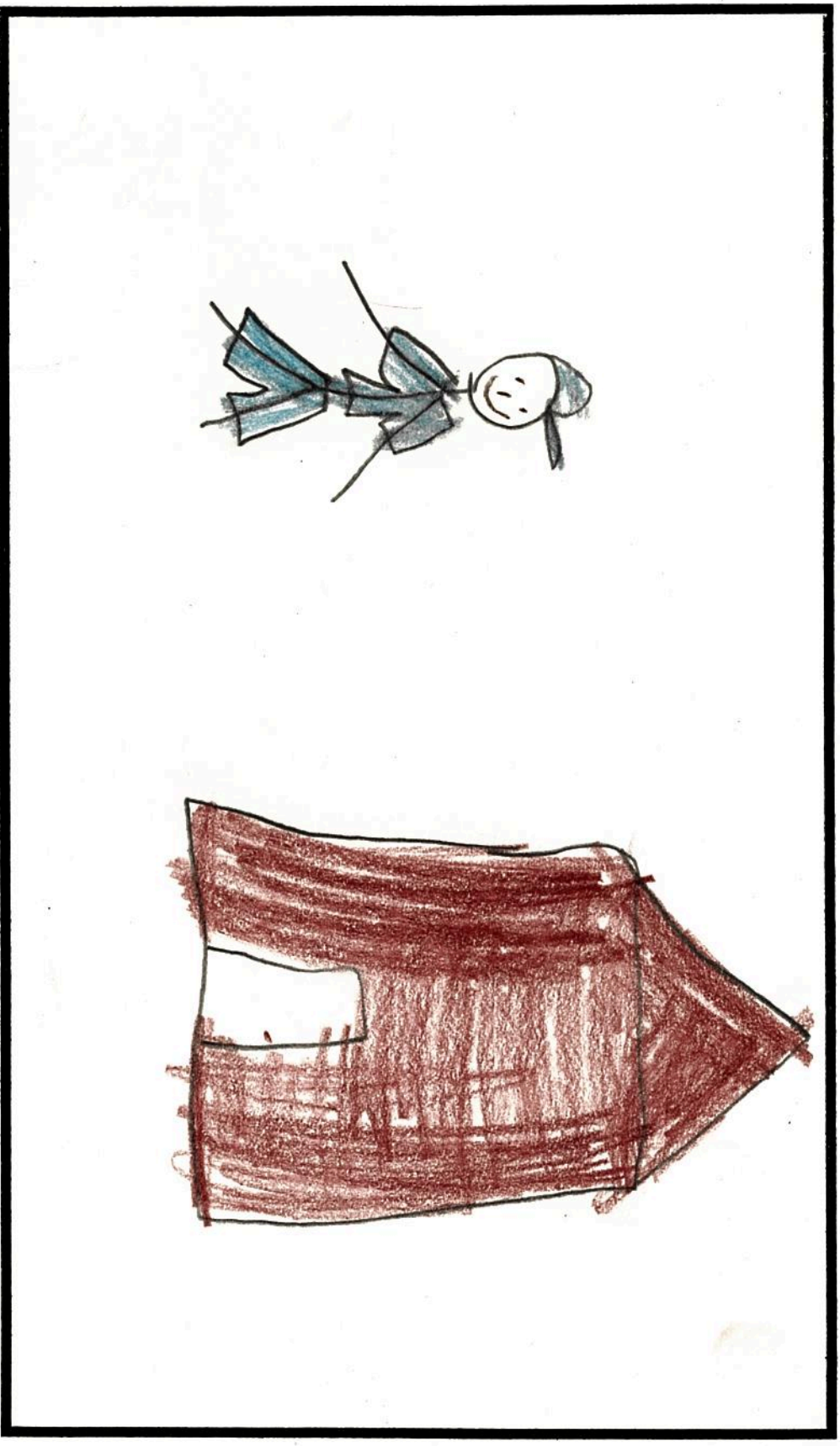
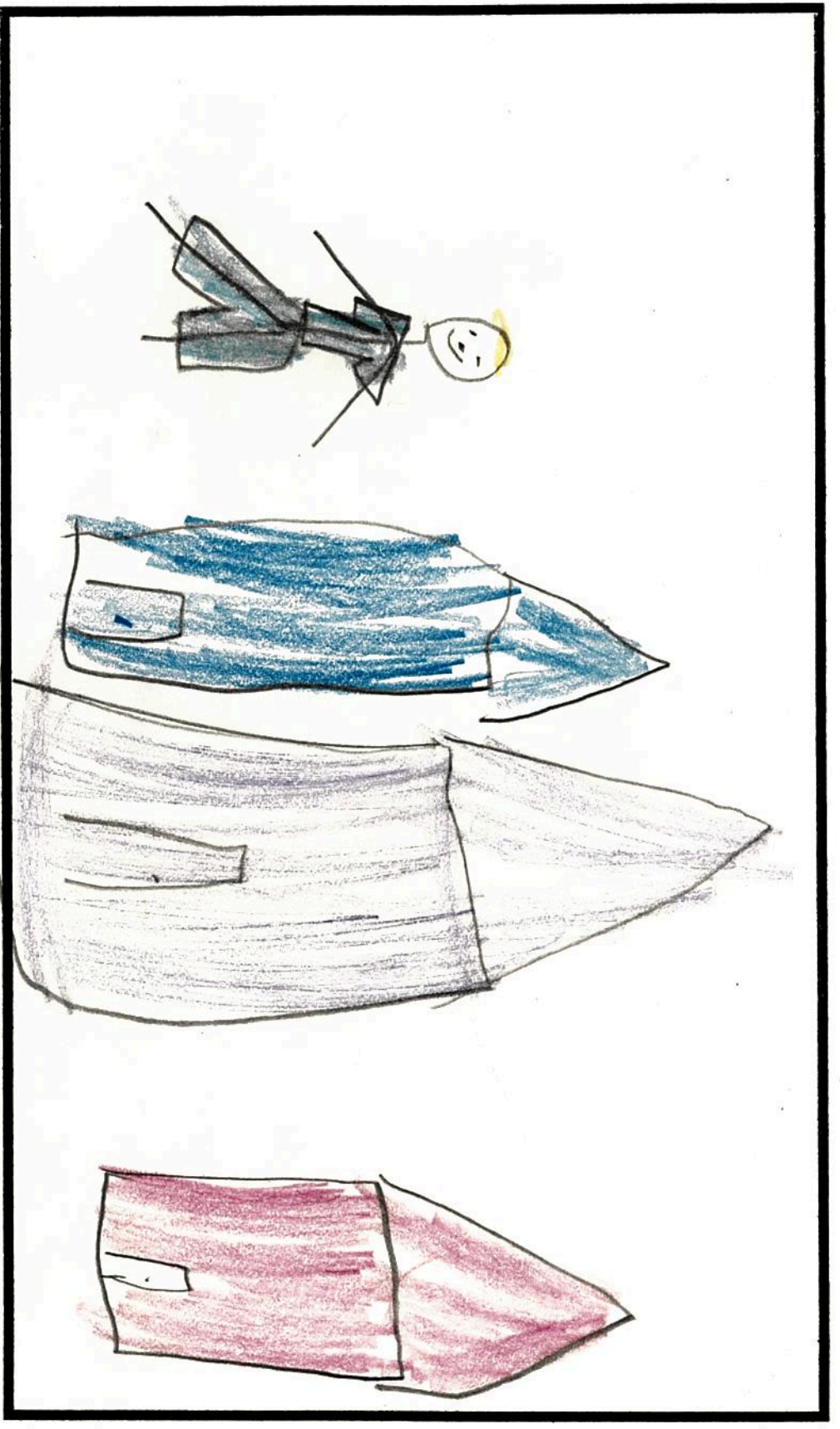


The Blue Yo-Yo

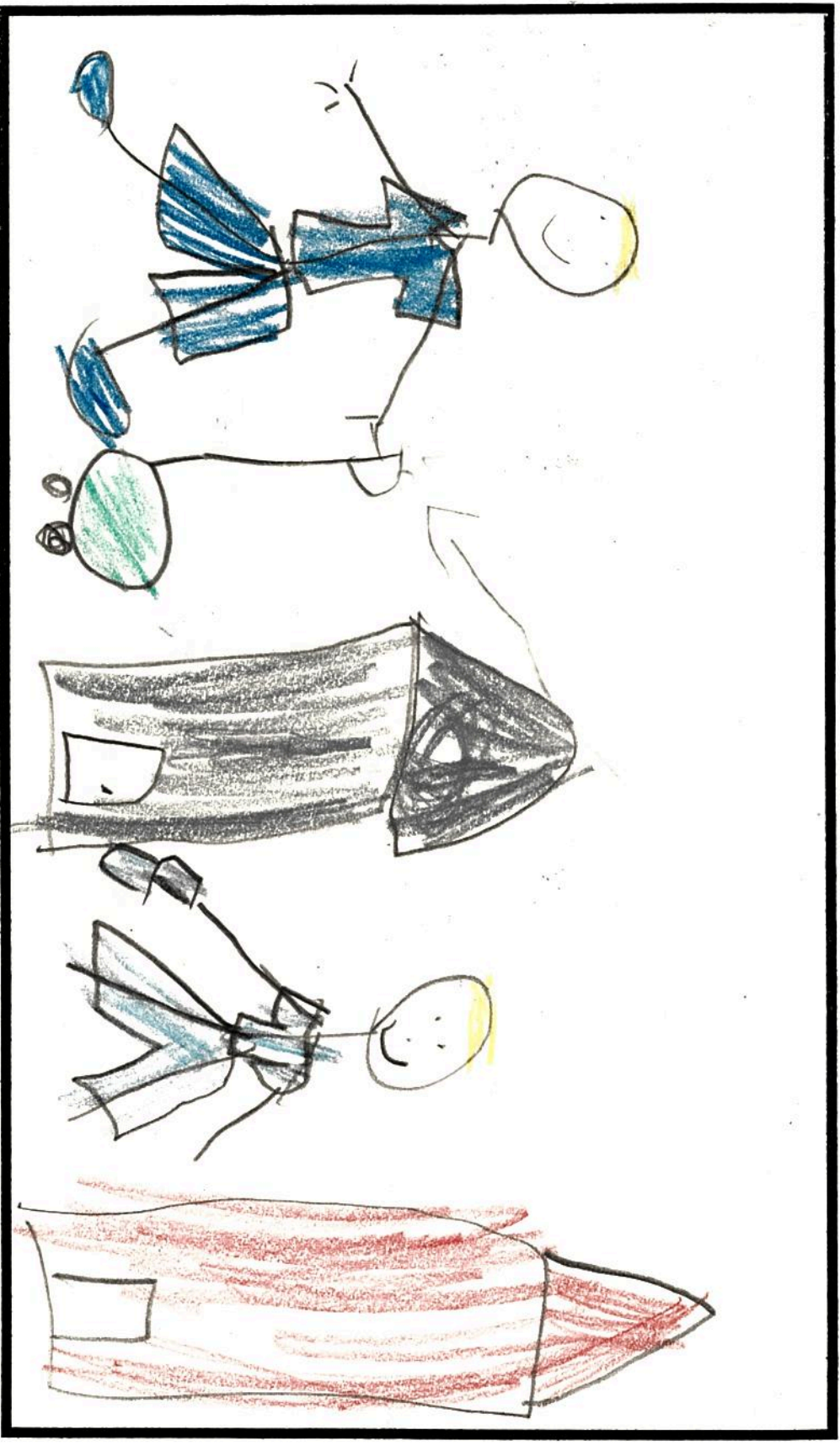

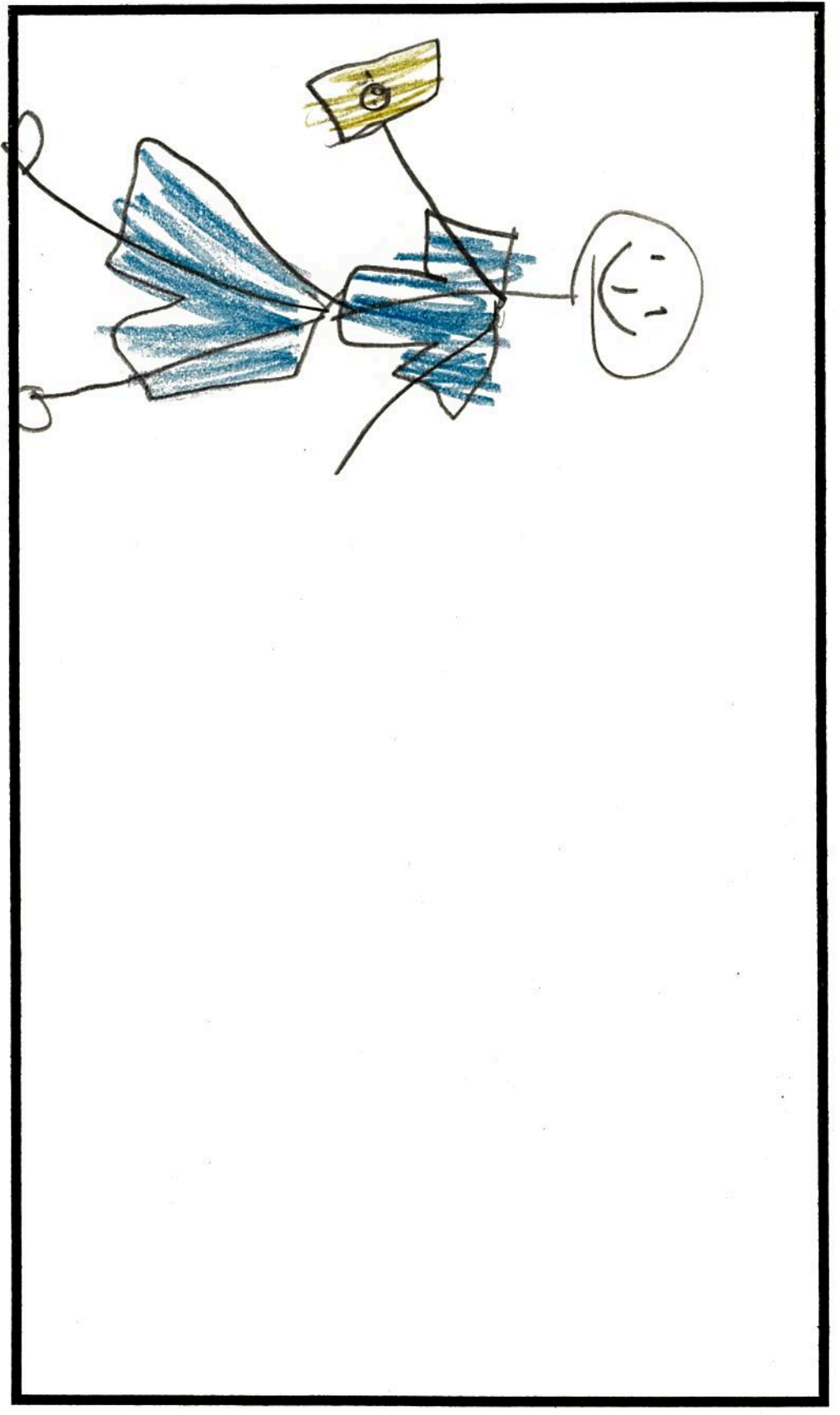

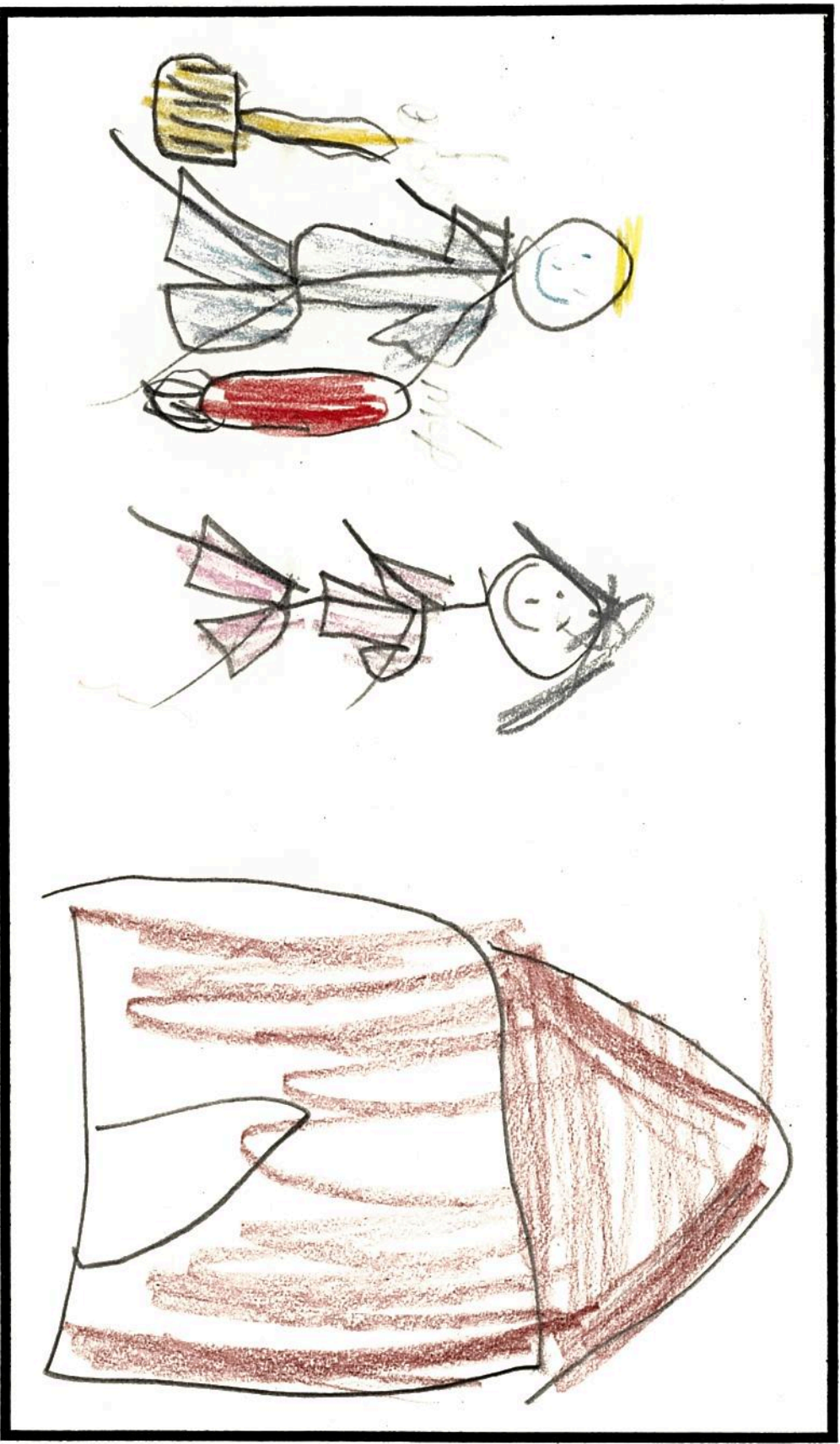
