The subject of Speaking and Listening is separated into two categories. Resources in Comprehension and Collaboration include lesson plans that encourage analyzing and comparing perspectives, as well as writing a rap with story elements. In Presentation of Knowledge and Ideas, students can explore how to map their ideas and find suggestions on how to communicate in a professional environment.
