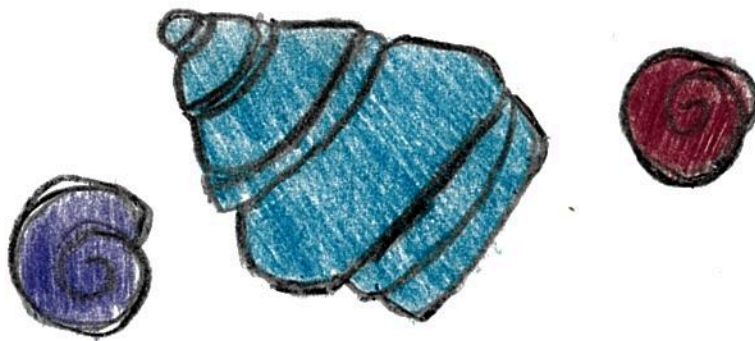


Brickly Part 2:
